



Board of Directors Present: Irene D'Aloisio, Molly Westgate, Gloria Wilson, George Anderson, Cindy Ryan

Treasurer's Report: Balance is \$6,136.57

By-Laws: The new by-laws were approved by 96% in favor of the change. According to the new by-laws, there will no longer be an advisor, so many thanks were given to Bob Michael for all his help. Let it be recorded in the minutes that he did not look terribly sad.

New Website: Our new website, <u>www.slpcc.net</u>, is up and electronic voting went well on it. We are also taking payments for various activities on website.

Social: The Ring in the New Year Social is January 16th and people should sign in on their regular play schedule. The format is round robin.

Training: A training clinic will be held on February 3rd with Laura Fenton Kovanda for levels 3.0, 3.5 and up. The fee is \$50 and registration will be done on the club website as well as making an electronic payment there for the class desired.

Rating Sessions: Rating sessions will be held on January 16, 22, and 29. Members were instructed to send an email to Rex Daubenberger at slpccrating@gmail.com if a rerating is desired.

Chelsea: There have been addition delays but hopefully the club will get training clinics as soon as possible. If members already have a number for the golf system, email Irene to give it to her.

3.5 Peer Review: New ratings will be on the next roster. The new schedule will have time slots for the 3.5+ group. Remaining 3.5 members will stay at that level for now

Referee Clinic: Let George Anderson know if you are interested in becoming a referee for the club. The clinic will be at the end of January or beginning of February

Scheduling: Lindi wants to know what the club wants or ideas on how we want scheduling to look like. She will send out a tentative schedule as a starting point to get opinions. The existing schedule is in effect until the end of January.
